* PCS must receive educational documentation by February 23 for the April 2012 examination and September 6 for the October 2012 examination. Educational documentation must be sent directly to PCS from the academic institution.

1. If you are currently enrolled in your last academic term (semester or trimester) you may apply by submitting a <u>Certificate of Enrollment</u>.

2. If you have completed all degree requirements but have not yet received your diploma from the university, you may apply by submitting a <u>Certificate of Graduation</u>.

3. If you have completed your degree, you must submit a <u>Final Official Transcript</u> with the degree and date conferred.

4. A final official transcript is required once the degree has been conferred. Your Engineering/Land Surveying Examination grades will not be released until you have graduated and complied with this request.

The 8-hour Lateral Forces (Wind/Earthquake) component is offered only on Saturday and focuses on wind/earthquake loads.
